The number of people in **England** who have tried to **quit smoking** since the **Stoptober** campaign was launched **10 years** ago

6m+

adults in England **still smoke**, which causes almost **75,000 preventable deaths** a year

45%

of **smokers** surveyed said they have been **smoking more** since the first **lockdown** began

1 in 10

people in the **UK** are predicted to have **diabetes** by **2030** if there is no significant government action – that's up to **5.5m people**, says Diabetes UK

32%

The year-on-year **decrease** in **sexually transmitted infection** diagnoses in **2020**, although this is thought to be due to **Covid-19** disruption

10%

The **drop** in **consultations** at sexual health services during the same period

35%

The **drop** in **face-to-face consultations**. But **internet** consultations **doubled**, found Public Health England

18%

The number of people in **Wales** who reported consuming **more alcohol 12 months** after the **first lockdown** than they did prior to the pandemic, which equates to about **445,000 adults**
