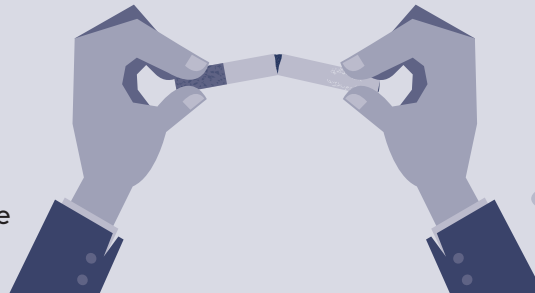

Smokers under 30 are more than twice as likely to have **stopped** smoking because of **Covid-19** than **those over 50**, suggests an analysis of **1370 smokers** and recent ex-smokers. However, **young people** may be more likely to **struggle with relapse**



45%

of **parents** believe **childhood immunisations** are now **more important than** they were **before Covid-19**, found a poll of more than **2500 adults**

However, only

27%

of **parents** felt **comfortable** taking their child (**from 9 months to 10 years old**) to a medical centre for vaccinations, due to **fear of exposure** to Covid-19
